Activities take place **two evenings per week from 6 PM to 8 PM**. Some Saturday activities, such as field trips or sports events, are also offered. The Program maintains a safe environment that emphasizes the development of the following core values: *positive self esteem; mutual respect; acquiring leadership; learning/education; employment readiness; spirituality; having fun; and building community*. Y.P.E. is a collaboration of City Mission Society, St. Mark Congregational Church, Greater Generations Tabernacle, and Bethel Pentecostal Church.
